FROM THE DESK OF OUR PASTOR



In our world today the role of fatherhood has become less clear. Some even question whether fathers are necessary at all. Recently, I came across a quote of St. John Paul II concerning his father and the influence he had on the late Pope's vocation: "day after day I was able to observe the austere way in which he lived. By profession he was a soldier and, after my mother's death, his life became one of constant prayer. Sometimes I would wake up during the night and find my father on his knees, just as I would always see him kneeling in the parish church. We never spoke about a vocation to the priesthood, but his example was in a way my first seminary, a kind of domestic seminary."

Kids learn so much about the world through watching their parents. What parents value, the children most often choose to value. Remember, a parent's example is significant. A dad once asked me, how do I get young people interested in their faith? The church doesn't seem to present it in a way that captures their attention. In response I asked him, do you pray in front of your kids? Do they see in you how important your faith is? If you have a passion for sports and it is on the TV all the time, chances are your kids will

have a passion for sports. If you have a visible passion for your faith that is where the seeds are planted. It begins and is nurtured at home with the parents, not the church.

On this very special day I think of my father who inspired me in so many ways. When he lost his job with a large family to care for he never gave up or became despondent or afraid. His example inspired me just to do the best I can despite the outcome. We always made time to pray together as a family. As a Deacon, he showed me that to truly minister always begins and ends with family. Everyone was his brother or sister who he always cared for with love, acceptance and presence.

He encouraged us to love the amazing adventure of life, our hopes, our dreams and our beautiful world but always remembering to love and thank God first! So much I could say about my father and all he taught me by his life. It is a very humbling privilege for me to embrace the title 'father' as a priest when I consider my own father and indeed all fathers with the immeasurably important role they live in the family, our Church and in our world. Thank you all for your lives and example!

FEAST OF FAITH

The Collection: A Privilege

As the altar is prepared for the celebration of the Eucharist, the collection is taken up. In the early church, this part of the Mass must have been something to behold, as the people suddenly began to move, bringing forward to the deacons and priests freshly-baked bread and fine wine. Then, after the Eucharistic Prayer, that same community came forward again in the Communion procession, and they received back the very gifts they had given, now transformed into something infinitely more precious than bread and wine: the very Body and Blood of Christ.

Beginning around the eleventh century, it became the custom for people to present money instead of bread and wine, and the procession of the faithful gradually disappeared (it survives in the liturgy of Holy Thursday). But the meaning is the same. **We continue to bring the fruit of our labors and to offer them freely to God.** And God continues to transform them into Christ. It is through our generous sharing of time, talent, and treasure that our parishes can preach the gospel, reach out to the sick and the imprisoned, and celebrate the sacraments.

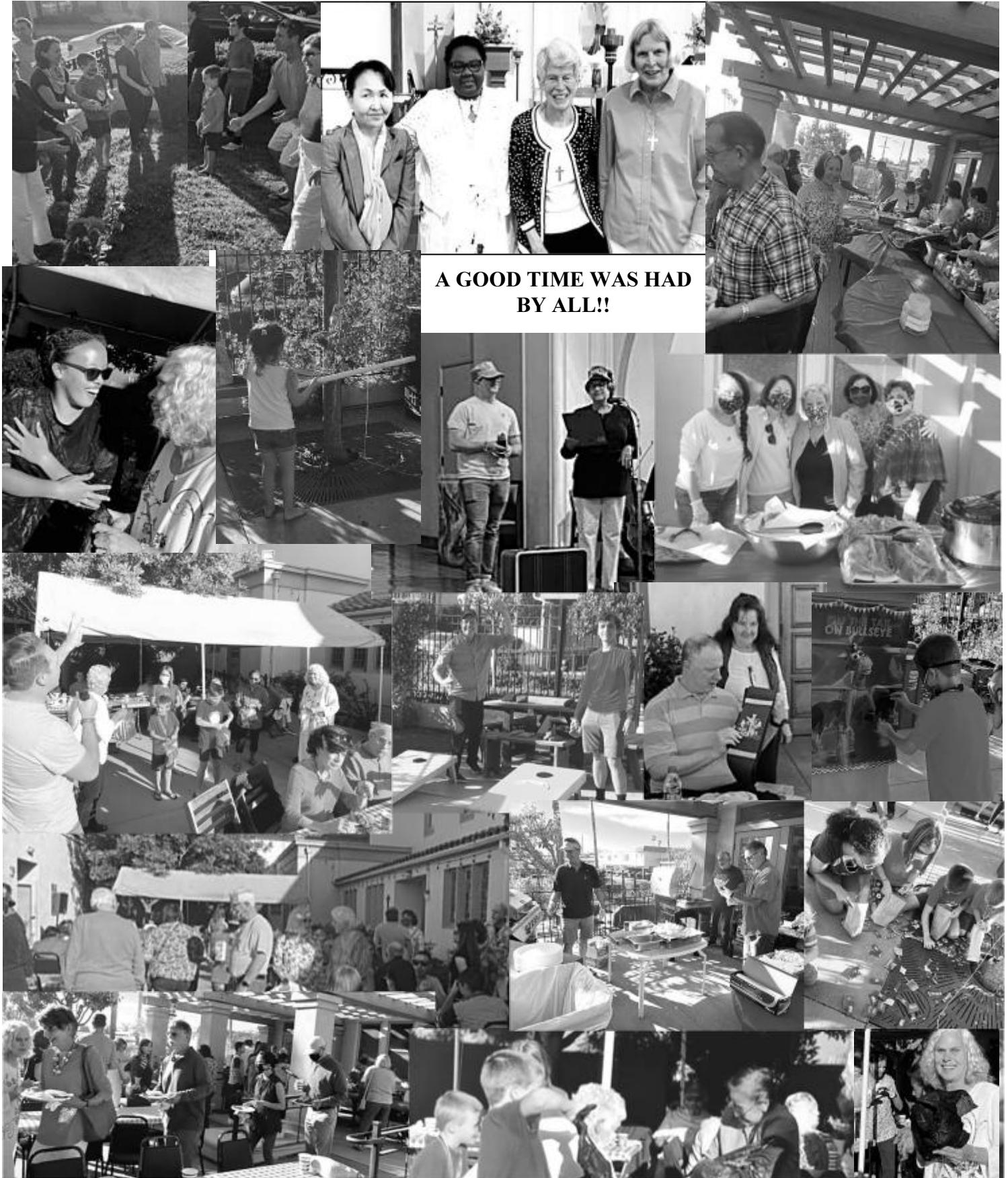

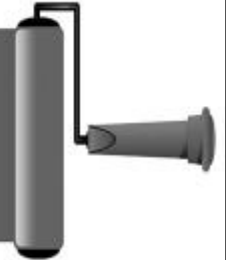
