TOUCHING THE CLOAK OF CHRIST

Look to today's Gospel and you'll find one of the most arresting images in all of Scripture. Christ in a crowd, everyone clamoring for his attention, pressing against him. Several feet away, is a chronically ill woman, weak and desperate for help. She knows she doesn't have a chance of getting his attention. She has no connections. She has no strength. All she can do is lift up her hand.

So that's what she does. She reaches out.

There comes a time, or maybe several times, in each of our lives when we become this woman. We're tired and we're sick. Is it with sin? With fear? With anger? It doesn't matter. Whatever it is, it's made us weak, and we feel like we've run out of options. We've looked for help and come up empty. We've consulted friends and gotten nowhere. We're lost in the crowd of life, unable to stick our heads above the pressing throng to wave for help.

And there is Christ, always passing by us. The hem of his cloak is never far from our grasp. We have no hope of a big miracle like the synagogue leader. We don't even bother asking for that. But that cloak ... we can touch that cloak. That's something we can do.

Do we do it, though? Do we have the confidence of that sick, beaten-down woman who knew so totally that healing was there for the taking? Or do we retreat back into the crowd, stumbling back home with our pain and our sinfulness? Reach out, friends. However, whatever, whenever — reach out. Christ will not fail you.

RESTRICTIONS LIFTED BY BISHOP McELROY!

Dear Sacred Heart Family,

On June 15th, we received updated guidance pertaining to state and county regulations. In response to the latest news, the bishops met and after in a letter to all priests, Bishop McElroy provided the following update:

- All the restrictions on capacity and spacing for worship and all limitations on meetings and social activities are lifted as of June 17, 2021.
- Masks will be optional. No one is to ask whether someone has been vaccinated or not. "Please don't judge others. If I stop judging others, I free myself from being judged and I can dance!" Patti Digh
- Distribution of the Eucharist may again be received on the tongue or will continue to be available in the hand.
- The reintroduction of the shared cup will be determined sometime in the future.
- Alterations in liturgical spaces and practices necessitated by the pandemic can now cease at the discretion of the pastor. This includes filling the fonts.
- It is recommended that non-family members bringing Eucharist to the sick should be vaccinated.
- We no longer will video / live stream outside Masses as of July 1st.

The dispensation from the normal obligation to attend Sunday Mass will end on July 1st.

We are grateful for this update as we plan for the full reopening of our catechetical ministries and activities this summer and fall. Particularly, we are grateful to our dedicated staff and volunteers for navigating this past year with all its uncertainties and changes with astounding faith and grace.

Here's a "**shout out**" to **Gregg & June Sprosty**, our live-stream pioneers who stepped up and contributed their talents to help us out, and very special kudos to **Janice Teixeira and the Opening Team Committee** who faithfully navigated us through the virtual journey during the pandemic. 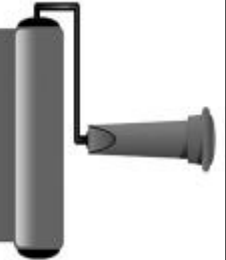
