

# MISSIONARY COOPERATION PLAN

On October 2-3, Fr. Emmanuel and Fr. Clement Iorliam, a priest of the Diocese of Gboko, Nigeria will be speaking on the help needed at the Diocese of Sokoto, Nigeria. The Dominican Frs. (OP) from Illinois USA started the Diocese of Sokoto in 1964.

The diocese is located in the northern part of Nigeria where Moslems are 95 percent in the majority. Those in the diocese have been going through a lot of Persecutions that result in the destruction and burning of churches and Rectories. In some parts of the diocese, the Catholic faithful worship in open places where they are sometimes beaten by rain and scorching sun.


The Catholic population is mostly petty traders, students, and most of them depend on the church for support. Given the economic, religious and political situation in the diocese, they depend on

their foreign friends for support.

The Diocese will use part of the funds from this Missionary Cooperation Plan to rebuild some of the Churches and Rectories that have been destroyed and the other part to complete a 2 story multi-purpose events center which is under construction. The project will accommodation provide for conferences, seminars, workshops, and also living accommodation for widows and orphans who live in rural areas and come to the city for empowerment workshops. Currently, the project is on hold now for lack of funds. Your generosity will go along way to alleviate their suffering.





## **Breaking the Stewardship Mold**

Have you noticed how we always tend to pigeonhole one another - and ourselves? "I could never serve on the Parish Council. That's for Rick and Ellen and that whole group of people who have done it for years." "Greg takes care of faith formation in the parish — he always has. He doesn't need my help." "I can't afford to give the big bucks like those families who sit up front can. My offering wouldn't matter even if I did increase it.'

Thinking like this is a good indication that we aren't in conversation with God about what His will is for our lives. If we have already decided what we are and are not meant to do, we aren't likely to pray over it, to discern it.

We have to be open to the spirit of the Lord wherever it leads us, regardless of what we or others have come to expect from us. We human beings come to believe that we are such good judges of what others can offer - or what we ourselves can offer. But God has plans for us to which we aren't privy. God calls everyone to serve Him in the way that pleases Him best, and only He can decide what that is.

Everyday Stewardship demands a continual accounting of who we can be, what we can offer — even if it's outside our comfort zone, even if it's something that never occurred to us before.

There's only one Person who can tell us what God wants from us. Do we even think to ask Him?
