Standing Reports

- **Preschool - Rebecca Godina** - facility experienced leaking during storms; fixed now. Window replacement project is moving forward with measuring to happen in February.
2 new students start Monday. Families in general are struggling financially; County offers assistance; number of families on assistance has jumped from 2 to 13. Suggestion to submit preschool art to parish bulletin as a way to promote.
- **Youth Ministry - John Maxwell** - Bishop Felip Pulido will preside at confirmation. Lenten small group to use the Live Lent book.

Old Business

- **Installation Mass** - Fr. Billy expressed his gratitude for the beautiful celebration that was both communal and personal, and for the support and confidence of our parish community.
- **Synod** - Fr. Billy and Kate McKenzie will attend a synod meeting at the Pastoral Center on Feb 20. Pope Francis asks each diocese to reflect on this question: *How do the current diocesan and parish structures encourage or impede the formation of a synodal church which reflects co-responsibility of all?* Discussion about how to communicate synodality to parishioners.
- **Security** - Fr. Billy invited discussion about security features like keys, doors, codes, cameras and access to parish buildings. Concern raised about the safety of the hanging statue of the Holy Family in the church near the back pews; several parishioners have bumped into it.
- **Bulletin ad for Spiritual Ministry Center** - SMC is grateful for the bulletin ad, but Sr. Bunny Flick, RSCJ retires in May, and it is better to wait for that transition.

- Fr. Billy asks for help with ACA this weekend. Need 4 ministers per Mass to hand out pamphlets/pens. Kate will ask ministers.
