



Won't You Come and Pray with Me Awhile?

The Sacred Triduum begins with *The Mass of the* TRIDUUM Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday and concludes with Evening Prayer on Easter Sunday. It is one

continuous celebration as we accompany Jesus on his final journey. We are there with Jesus in the Upper Room as we wash each other's feet and we share in his Body and Blood. Next we solemnly follow Jesus to the "Garden of Gethsemane" in the Altar of Repose. Jesus asks us to stay and pray with him awhile as he prays in mental anguish to his Father. At 10:00 PM, we quietly leave for our homes and continue to contemplate and commemorate all that Jesus experienced after his arrest. "Good Friday is a somber remembrance of Jesus' crucifixion and death on the cross. It is a day of **fasting and abstinence** and a time to examine all the places in our lives where we fail to follow Christ and fall into sin" (OSV: *Holy Week*.) The somberness of Good Friday gives way to the joy of Jesus' Resurrection and the celebration of new life through Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil, the highest point of the entire Church year.

This year, on **Holy Thursday**, we will again collect **new socks** for our unsheltered neighbors. This is to remember and honor Our Lord washing the feet of His disciples during the Last Supper.



GOSPEL MEDITATION

"As he rode along, the people were spreading their cloaks on the road." (Luke 19:36)

Consider how useless it is to spread your clothes on the ground for a donkey to walk on. The clothes get smeared with hooves, and who knows the grimy places where they've been? The animal may leave some unsavory presents on them. They may get stolen by a thief looking to make a buck. The thorns, thistles, rocks and muck of the road will leave stains. The clothes may never be useful again, and you'll probably walk home shivering without your normal covering. Yet this is precisely the gesture the people employ to welcome Jesus and his donkey. Why does this detail matter?

Wastefulness is an essential part of celebration. Consider the unnecessary extravagance of Christmas decorations, confetti and ticker tape parades, baseball players spraying each other with bottles of champagne after a victory, birthday gifts for kids and so on. This wastefulness signals celebration and therefore participation in higher identities (as believers, winners, and parents, to mention the above examples). That's what the wasted cloaks are all about. Those who donate their cloaks participate in Christ's kingship in Jerusalem — and we savor it two thousand years later.

The lesson? Learn how to "waste" money, time, clothes, and food on Christ. We do this at Mass, but in so many other ways, too, like serving the poor, going on retreats, and doing prayerful study. When we practice this holy wastefulness, Jesus will ride into our lives and we'll be more deeply members of his kingdom.

In the prelude to today's great Passion Narrative, Saint reminds us that we find our hope in the "emptiness" and "humility" of Christ Jesus; a life that led to the cross, but through the cross, to glory and exaltation. The way is not easy. Good stewards know that it requires a willingness to lay aside all rights of personal privilege; emptying ourselves in the service embracing others; values different from the values of the world. It requires understanding that to be "in Christ" means to be a servant because Christ came into the world, not as Lord but as servant. What crosses are we willing to carry? What worldly values we are willing to forego in order to share Christ's glory?
